Conference Venue Accommodation of Sponsored Participants	The North Campus of the University of Cape Coast, Ghana All sponsored participants have been booked at Hotels or Guest Houses which provide bed and breakfast and other amenities. (Details are as provided in your personalized invitation letter/email). On arrival at the hotel, please check in at the hotel reception by identifying yourself as a	
	participant of the African Nutrition Conference. Confirm your check out date with the hotel.

Ground Transportation	On arrival at the airport, look out for the ANC2024/ANEC IX booth in the international arrival area. Conference delegates who paid for airport pickup should check in at the ANC2024/ANEC IX booth and observe arrangements for the 2.5-hour shuttle to Cape Coast.	
	Conference participants can travel from Kotoka International Airport to Takoradi by air (a 40-minute flight), and then drive to Cape Coast in one hour. If you need a pickup at the Takoradi airport, please arrange it in advance with the Local Organizing Committee. [Local flights to Takoradi may be booked with Africa World Airlines <a href="https://booking.flyafricaworld.com/booking/">https://booking.flyafricaworld.com/booking/</a> or PassionAir <a href="https://flypassionair.com/book-now/">https://flypassionair.com/book-now/</a> ]	
	In case you need to use a hired taxi, use the yellow taxi outside the airport terminal or inform the ANC2024 front office/reception at the airport to call for you one of the secure mobile app taxis that operate similar to Uber or Bolt in other countries.	
	In Cape Coast, there will be shuttle transport to and from all conference listed hotels (where indicated). You will need to communicate to both reception of your selected hotel and/or the GAND-LOC your date/time of arrival and departure at least 3 days prior to your scheduled travel.	
Security and Clearance	Please present yourself by showing your passport or national identification card at the entrance gates of the conference venue when requested by the security officer on duty. You will be issued a badge at the Registration Desk.	
Visa	Visitors to Ghana must obtain a visa from one of Ghana's diplomatic missions unless they are citizens of a visa-exempt country or a country whose citizens are eligible for visa on arrival. Visitors may also obtain an electronic visa. Visitors must have a passport that is valid for at least six months.	





	Registered conference delegates can either: (1) Apply directly at Ghana's embassy, consulate or Council offices in their respective countries for visa. [for more information, see <a href="https://www.gis.gov.gh/visa permits.html">https://www.gis.gov.gh/visa permits.html</a> ]  Or

	Countries who do not require visa to enter Ghana include: (1) all ECOWAS Countries, (2) South Africa (3) Kenya (4) Uganda and (5) Tanzania

Time Zone	The Time Zone in Cape Coast is GMT+0, Greenwich Mean Time (GMT), No daylight savings.
Reimbursable Expense	For sponsored participants, please bring your original boarding pass and hand it in to the ANS finance official who will be processing your travel grants or related allowances to claim your in-country travel expenses. Please note that personal vehicle fuel costs are not reimbursable! Also, for sponsored participants, please keep the receipts and present them to validate your costs.
Health (Medical)	All travelers to Ghana must hold a passport valid for at least six (6) months and a yellow fever vaccine card. You are advised to keep your COVID-19 vaccination certificate should it be requested.
Badges	All conference participants will receive conference badges. Wearing these badges are mandatory throughout the conference hours to secure entrance to the premises.
Working Language	English is the working of the conference. Some translation services may be available
Currency	The official currency in Ghana is the Ghana Cedis (GHS). The current exchange rate is 1 USD = 15.38 Ghanaian cedis (As at July 1, 2024)
Catering	Lunch and snack refreshments will be provided at the venue.
Weather	In Cape Coast, the climate is wet (with 278mm of precipitation over 16 days) during October. The temperature fluctuates between 25 ° C and 29 ° C. The average in October in Cape Coast is 27 ° C. The weather in Cape

Electricity Supply	In Ghana there are two associated plug types, D and G. Plug type G (the
	most common) has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern, while type
	D has three round pins in a triangular pattern. Both types have a standard voltage of 220V at a frequency of 50 Hz. The plugs are also hybrids of both
	types D and G.
